CAMP HINDS TRAIL TO EAGLE WEEK ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

During Week 1 (July 1st to the 6th) Camp Hinds will again be offering our special Trail to Eagle Advancement Camp. This is only open to Scouts who are at least First Class and at least 13 years old as of June 1, 2007. This is an intensive advancement program with most of the Eagle required merit badges being offered. In order to take these merit badges a Scout must be registered in the Eagle Week program. A provisional troop exclusively for the TTE Scouts will be offered for those Scouts attending this program. Scouts should be aware that most of these merit badges requires work that is done outside of camp. In order to have the merit badge completed by the end of the week the Scout should bring his work to camp.

EAGLE MERIT BADGE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS



Citizenship in the

Nation: Visit the national or a state capitol or tour a federal instillation. (Bring a note from a parent.) Be ready to explain your experiences.



Citizenship in the World:

Be ready to give a brief oral report and a written report to your counselor about a particular international issue. *Alternative options are described in Req. 9



Citizenship in the

Community: Bring a map of your community. Attend local government meeting or court hearing. (Bring a note from a parent.)



Communications:

Attend a public meeting where several points of view are given on a single issue. (Bring a note from a parent.) Present a report of all the views expressed.



Personal Management:

Must complete req. 1 and 2 with family. (Involves household planning and budgeting) These requirements together take at least 13 weeks.



Personal Fitness:

Scouts must design their own fitness plan (Req. 7) and execute that plan (Req. 8), which together takes at least 12 weeks.
